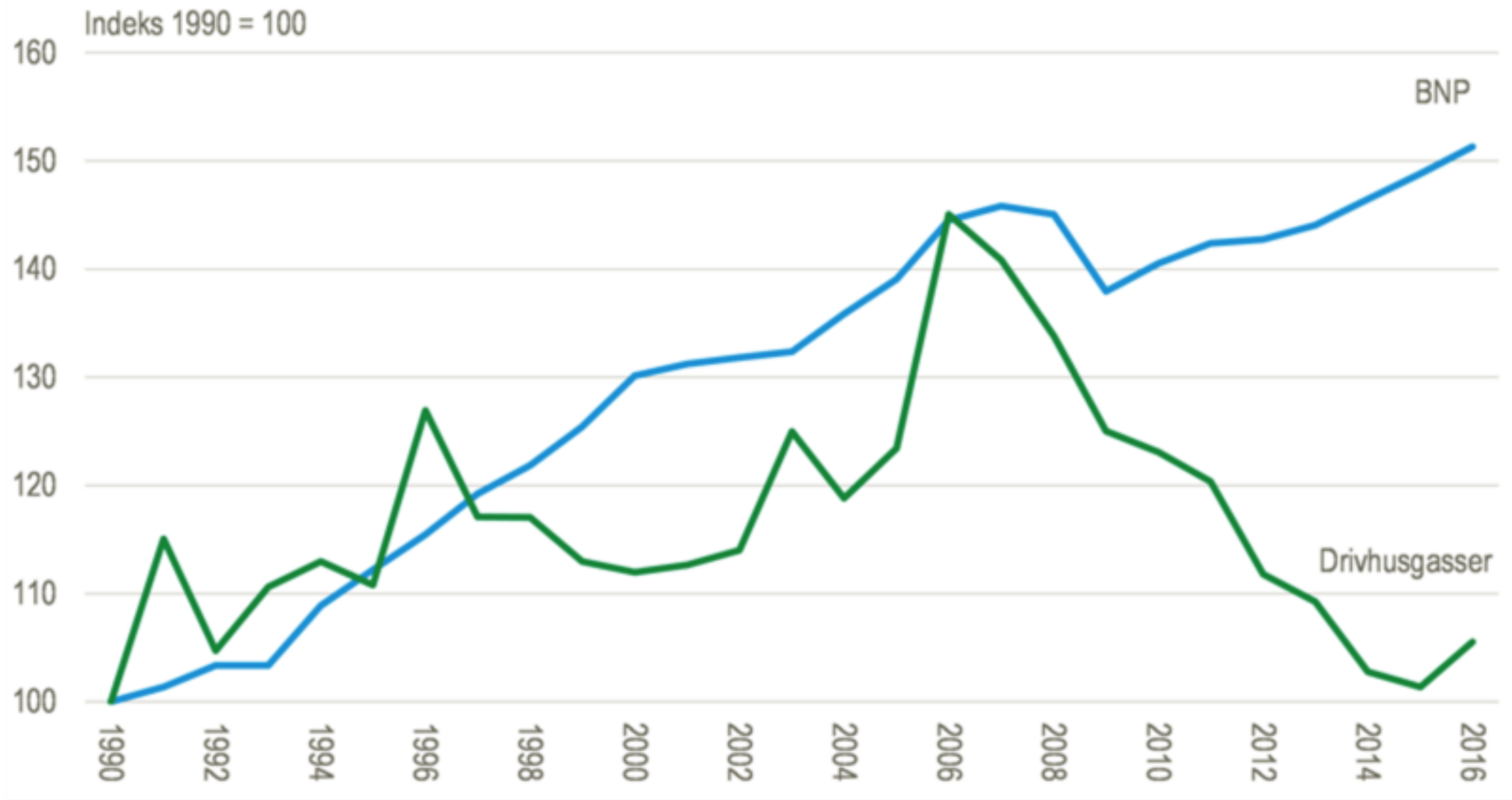

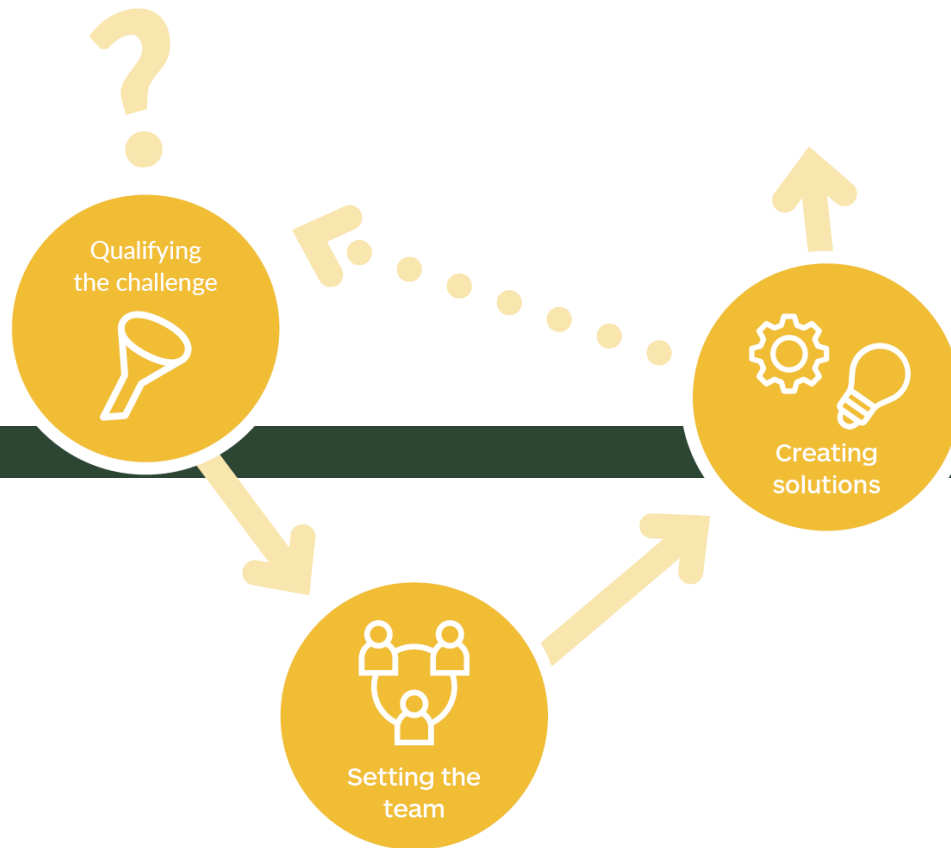

BUSINESS MATCH

Business Match is a tailored 1-3 day workshop with a focus on innovation.

Through our multidisciplinary approach, we mobilize the BLOXHUB ecosystem to address and elevate your business challenge.

The Business Match workshop is based on your specific challenge framed to create value for all participants. The expected value is increased innovation capacity, new business ideas and new partnerships.



GLOBAL BUSINESS MATCH

Global Business Match is a full-scale international match making program.
Duration: Tailored workshops 2 to 6 days and 3 to 6 months end-to-end.

Through our design-based multidisciplinary approach we mobilize the BLOXHUB ecosystem to ideate and create solutions and business models for a specific urban challenge of yours. The challenge is identified by an international "challenge owner" and together we ideate and create.

CASE EXAMPLE 1

RETHINKING REHOUSING

The story:

ENERGY OPTIMIZATION IN RIGA

The story:

Recently, we went to Riga, Latvia, to match the city council and city architect with several companies from the BLOXHUB community. The purpose was to work together with the city on new concepts for energy optimization of older apartment buildings. When completed, the concepts will benefit thousands of homes in Riga - and reduce emissions!
